1979 CEAL Annual Meeting. The 1979 Annual Meeting of CEAL is now scheduled to take place on March 29, 1979, in Los Angeles. This is in response to membership requests that CEAL continue to hold its Annual Meeting ahead of the AAS meetings in order to make possible CEAL members' attendance at other AAS panels. The CEAL Executive Group will meet in the evening of March 28, 1979. Details of the meetings and other activities will be announced in the February issue of the *CEAL Bulletin*. It is now planned that a discussion on automation will be part of the program for the CEAL Annual Meeting. Other suggestions for the agenda are welcome and should be addressed to the Chairperson of CEAL.

AAS Library Panel. Raymond N. Tang, Head, East Asiatic Library, University of California, Berkeley, has organized a panel on "Libraries and Publishing in the People's Republic of China" for the 1979 AAS Annual Meeting. Papers will be given by Antony Marr, Associate Curator, East Asian Collection, Yale University Library and Karl Lo, Head, East Asia Library, University of Washington. Weiyang Wan, Head, Asia Library, University of Michigan, will be the discussant. All have traveled to the PRC, with Mr. Marr having just recently returned to the United States. The time and place of the panel will be announced in the February issue of the *CEAL Bulletin* and in the official AAS program for the Los Angeles meeting.
