The Delno C. West Award is in honor of Professor Delno C. West (1936-1998), one of the founding members of the Rocky Mountain Medieval and Renaissance Association. Professor West was Professor of History at Northern Arizona University where he served for a time as Chair of the History Department and Director of the Honors Program. Professor West served as president of the Association and the general coordinator of three annual meetings held in Flagstaff and at the Grand Canyon. His teaching centered on medieval Europe, and he published widely on the history of Christianity. His numerous books and articles include *The Libro de las Profecias* of Christopher Columbus (1991).

The Delno C. West Award recognizes the most distinguished paper given by a senior scholar at the annual conference.
