Marian Robertson Wilson received a Ph.D. in French and in Music from the University of Utah. She left a long university teaching career to work for the *Coptic Encyclopedia* as a translator, author, and music editor. A born musician, she concertized from childhood both as a pianist and a 'cellist and was a prominent member of the Utah Symphony during the tenure of Maurice Abravanel.

John W. Welch is the Robert K. Thomas Professor of Law at BYU. He is the founding director of FARMS, editor in chief of *BYU Studies*, director of special projects at the BYU Religious Studies Center, and serves as director of publications for the Joseph Fielding Smith Institute.

Dennis and Sandra Packard live in Provo, Utah, and they are the parents of six children. Dennis is a professor of philosophy at BYU, and Sandra is a homemaker and freelance writer. They coauthored the book *Feasting upon the Word*.

Davis Bitton is emeritus professor of history at the University of Utah and for ten years was assistant church historian. His most recent publications are *Images of the Prophet Joseph Smith* and *George Q. Cannon: A Biography.* He also edited *Mormons, Scripture, and the Ancient World,* a collection of scholarly articles in honor of John L. Sorenson.

Kenneth W. Godfrey taught in the church educational system for thirtyseven years before his retirement. He has published articles in the *Illinois Historical Quarterly, Journal of Mormon History,* the *Utah Historical Quarterly, Cobblestone, BYU Studies,* and *Mormon Heritage.*
