FROM THE DESK OF THE CHAIRPERSON

Greetings to fellow CEAL members and friends. Once again, it is my pleasure to bring the following information and notices to your attention.

1982 CEAL Annual Meetings

The 34th Annual Meeting of the Association for Asian Studies will be held at the Palmer House, Chicago, April 2-4, 1982. CEAL will be requesting from the AAS Secretariat the following meeting assignments; all CEAL members will be notified of confirmation of the schedules as soon as they become finalized, probably in January.

Executive Group Meeting: 8 p.m. - 11 p.m., Wednesday (March 31)
CEAL Annual Meeting: 9 a.m. - 5 p.m., Thursday (April 1)
CEAL Fellowship Dinner: 6 p.m., Friday (April 2)
CEAL Subcommittee Meetings: Friday (April 2) and Saturday (April 3)

AAS panels will include at least one East Asian library related session:

"Collection Development in East Asian Collections: Trends and Problems," chaired by Dr. Richard C. Howard of the Library of Congress.

Election of Officers

The CEAL chairperson and four librarian members of the Executive Group will be elected next March, and their nomination and election will proceed as follows:

December 1, 1981: Nomination opens.

The Executive Group and subcommittee chairpersons will constitute the Nominating Committee, and it invites nominations from the membership.

January 15, 1982: Nomination closes.

All the nominations should reach the CEAL chairperson by January 15. The Nominating Committee will vote on the first roster of nominees, which will list all the names of persons who have been nominated.

February 15, 1982: The Nominating Committee will draw up the final list of nominees.

March 1, 1982: The ballots with names of final nominees will be distributed to all members in good standing and with voting rights (those who are AAS members and subscribers to the CEAL Bulletin).

March 31, 1982: The votes will be counted by the Executive Group and results announced at the Annual Meeting on the following day.

I look forward to seeing you and participating in another successful meeting in Chicago next Spring.
