Style Rules

ABSTRACTS (500 words) or POSITION PAPERS (1000 words) or RESEARCH PAPERS (3000 words) for TALKS & REFEREED PROCEEDINGS

Deadline: March 15, 2010

1. Send via email as an attached file in Microsoft Word (DOC file) format or Rich Text File (RTF) format to Michael Andregg, ISCS Program Chair, at: mmandregg@stthomas.edu
2. Paper TITLE in left-justified, bold 12 point Times Roman font. (Style: Title)
3. Then Authors & Affiliation, in normal (no bold or italic) 12 point Times Roman font. (Style: Author)
4. Author e-mail addresses, 12 point Times Roman. (Style: address)
5. Then a skip line
6. Then the word ABSTRACT-RESEARCH IN PROGRESS (500 words) or POSITION PAPER (1000 words) or RESEARCH PAPER (3000 words) on a line by itself in 12 Point Time Roman. (Style: Paper)
7. For POSITION PAPERS and RESEARCH PAPERS provide a short Abstract, up to a 25 words, justified in italics, 12 Point Times Roman. (Style: Abstract)
8. Then a skip line
9. Key words: provide 3-5 key words in bold, 12 Point Times Roman (Style: Keywords)
10. Section titles in left-justified, bold, 12 Point Time Roman. (Style: Section Title)
11. Text in 12 point Times Roman, justified, single spaced, 6 point space between paragraphs, no indent at the beginning of each paragraph. (Style: Text)
12. Footnote text in justified 12 point Times Roman, footnote numbers as superscript, article titles in quotes, and book or journal titles italicized. (Style Footnote Text)
13. References in APA style
14. Graphics or illustrations, which are enthusiastically encouraged, must be sent separately as attachments in the format in which they were created. All graphics must be grayscale, 300 dpi, and sized no greater than 4 inches by 5.5 inches (graphics may be rotated for optimum presentation). All graphics must be properly credited.
15. Run document through your word processor's spell-checker and grammar checker.
16. Send as DOC or RTF file to above email address.
