JAPANESE STUDIES LIBRARIAN, Graduate School of International Relations and Pacific Studies Library, University of California, San Diego. Associate Librarian I-V, \$37,932-\$47,604 or Librarian I-IV, \$50,988-\$64,188. Under the direction of the Head of the IR/PS Library, will be responsible for: collection development and management, reference and research services, and resource sharing programs in support of the study of Japan at UCSD. The Librarian will divide his/her time between two places in the UCSD Libraries: the IR/PS Library and the East Asia Collection in the main library.

QUALIFICATIONS: M.L.S. from an ALA-accredited library school (or proper equivalent); full proficiency in written and spoken Japanese and in the Hepburn romanization scheme; ability to communicate effectively in English; interpersonal skills needed to work effectively with colleagues and the research-oriented Japanese studies community; experience in collection development and reference; knowledge of Japanese publishing industry and knowledge of current trends in scholarship; research skills in both informational and bibliographic database and catalog searches; knowledge of relevant electronic sources and networks; experience in using and teaching online library catalogs, CS-ROM resources and other electronic tools, including the Internet. Preferred: an advanced degree in Japanese studies in one of the following fields: humanities, history, and social sciences; computing skills to work in an advanced technical environment; demonstrated adaptability to work independently in a rapidly-changing environment. Appointment at the Associate Librarian level requires substantial professional library experience and expertise; appointment at the Librarian level requires proven, substantial professional library experience and expertise with significant professional accomplishments and contributions, including recognized subject knowledge.
