Brent Pace is a French major.

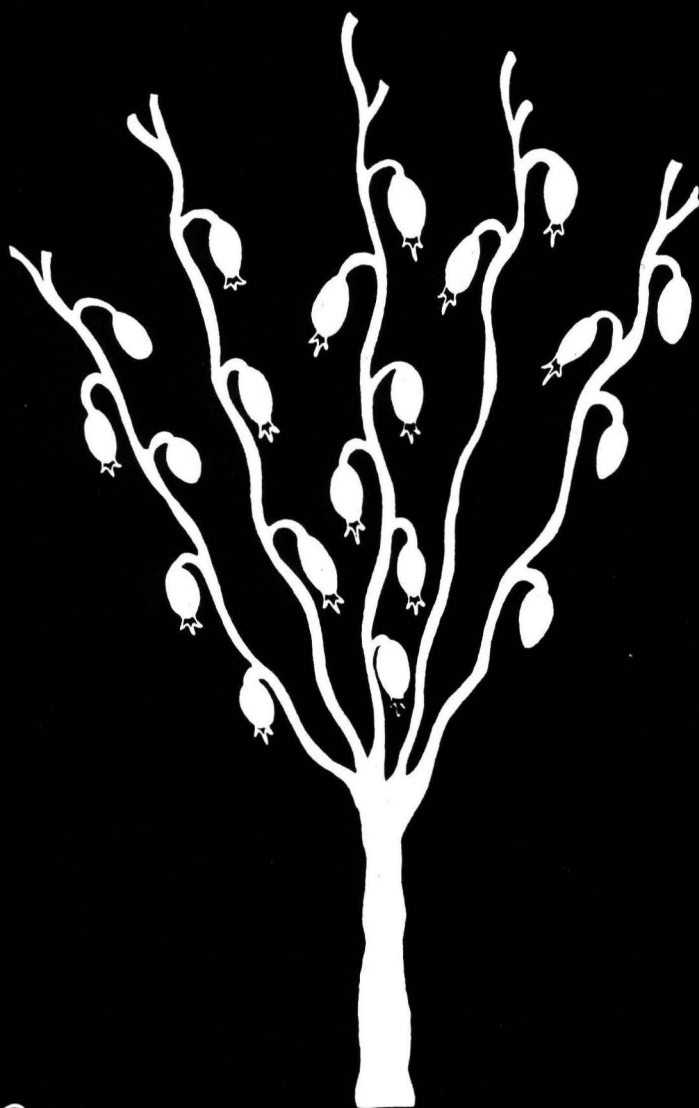
