Inscape has been published semi-annually since the fall of 1981. In this relatively short period, the journal has won much recognition for both graphic and literary excellence. In 1982 *Inscape* was awarded an Honorable Mention by the Coordinating Council of Literary Magazines in the Victoria Chen Haider Memorial College Literary Magazine Contest. This Competition is the foremost in the country and includes entries from most of the 50 states.
