Inscape has been published semi-annually since the fall of 1981. In this relatively short period, the journal has won much recognition for both graphic and literary excellence. In 1982 *Inscape* was awarded an Honorable Mention by the Coordinating Council of Literary Magazines in the Victoria Chen Haider Memorial College Literary Magazine Contest. This Competition is the foremost in the country and includes entries from most of the 50 states. In 1983 *Inscape* won six individual awards in the Rocky Mountain Collegiate Journalism Competition, and an Award of Merit for creative design from the Potlatch Paper Corporation. *Inscape* was also honored with a generous grant from the Utah Arts Council and from the National Endowment for the Arts in 1983 and again in 1984.
