Starr East Asian Library seeks a Tibetan Studies Librarian to develop and manage Columbia's Tibetan collection (including both Tibetan and Chinese language materials) and to assist with the Western language Tibetan studies collection. **This position is initially funded for 4 years with the possibility of extension.** C. V. Starr East Asian Library is one of the major collections for the study of East Asia in the United States, with nearly 785,000 volumes of Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Tibetan, and Western language materials and over 6,500 periodical titles.

Reporting to the Director, the Tibetan Studies Librarian will supervise one support staff member and student assistants. Responsibilities will include collection development, collection maintenance, reference, and cataloging.
