Peer-reviewed articles appear in the October issue; both issues include reports, book reviews and institutional and member news items. Articles submitted for peer review should represent original research and not be under consideration for publication elsewhere. Submissions should be in either WordPerfect or Microsoft Word and should be sent by email attachment to the *JEAL* Editor, Gail King, at [gail\\_king@byu.edu](mailto:gail_king@byu.edu).

Notes should be gathered at the end, and documentation should follow the *Chicago Manual of Style*. Deadlines for submissions are
