Fourteen children's book illustrators, including Tomie DePaola, Sophie Blackall, Brett Helquist, Yumi Heo, Peter H. Reynolds, David Small and others, create a humorous gallery of old and new knock-knock jokes. The variety of illustrative styles intensifies the enjoyment factor. As with *Why Did the Chicken Cross the Road* (Dial, 2006), this picture book is packed with talent and kid appeal. The last two-page spread asks the artists who they would want to knock at their doors, and the answers give readers a glimpse of the artists' personalities and wit. A good choice for public, school, and home libraries.
