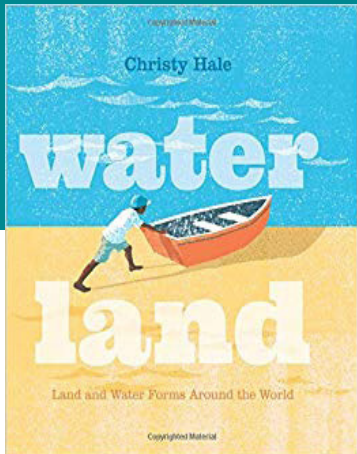

Ever wonder what the difference between a bay and a cape was? Or have no idea what the term isthmus means? With uniquely cut pages and a glossary of definitions, this book sets out to help readers understand what the terms we use to refer to land and water forms are and what they mean.

With colorful illustrations serving as the guide for understanding, Water Land is a great teaching tool to help kids understand different land and water forms and the terms associated with them. The book has terms such as island and lake in on the flip side of each other, with a shape cut out so that one page shows a lake, and when the page is flipped it shows an island. The cool page shapes and clear text, as well as a collection of terms in the back allow readers to get a better grasp on these terms and their definitions. It even has a fold out map in the back that shows examples of the land and water forms from around the world. A clever, educational book that kids will love!
