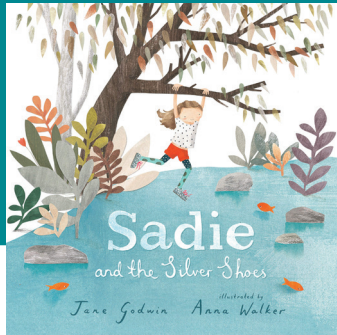

Despite only having one shoe, Sadie decides to wear it anyway because she loves it so much. Other girls make fun of her for wearing mismatched shoes, but Sadie doesn't care. One day, a new girl named Ellie comes to class. When Sadie invites Ellie over, Sadie gets a surprise that allows the girls to become friends.

This is a cute and entertaining story. The adorable collage illustrations use the mediums of pencil and watercolor, which varies their appearance and style. This variety makes for a cute patchwork theme that matches the feel of the story. The story can help children feel confident with their own clothing choices. It can also teach about friendship, since the two girls decided to share in the end.
